The *Institute for Biochemistry and Biology* at the *Faculty for Mathematics and Natural Sciences* of the University of Potsdam invites applications for

Full Professorship (W 3) for Biodiversity Research/Botany

to be filled immediately. The appointee will represent the full breadth of the field of Biodiversity Research/Botany with respect to research and teaching. Teaching at the undergraduate level will largely be in German, and relevant teaching experience is a prerequisite. The professorship includes the position of director of the Botanical Garden. Applicants should have an excellent and internationally competitive track record in a current area of functional biodiversity research as demonstrated by relevant publications and third-party funding. The candidate's research is expected to complement work by the other groups in the University research focus area "Functional Ecology and Evolution". The applicant's research should combine empirical and experimental research with ecological theory and allow collaboration with molecular plant sciences. The willingness to contribute to present and future joint research initiatives such as the Berlin-Brandenburg Institute for Biodiversity Research (BBIB) and the DFG-funded graduate school BioMove is expected.

The following application requirements for professors must be documented in accordance with Section 41 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act (Brandenburgisches Hochschulgesetz, BbgHG): a completed university degree, pedagogical aptitude, and a special ability for scientific work, as is typically documented by a dissertation project; comprehensive competences in science management and additional scholarly achievements as evidenced by a Habilitation (post-doctoral dissertation), a junior professorship or work as a research associate at an institution of higher education or an extramural research institution, or scholarly activity in the private sector, or in a similar social field, whether in Germany or abroad. The appointment procedure is conducted in accordance with Section 40 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act.

The University strives for a balanced gender ratio at all levels. Severely disabled applicants will be given preferential consideration in the event of equal qualification. We expressly invite applications from people with migration backgrounds.
